

# Semester Test Schedule

Fall 2018

Thursday Dec. 20th – **Odd class periods – 1,3,5,7.** Each class will be 2 periods long. The first period can be used to study and the second for giving the test. We will still have breaks between each period. If teachers need more time to give the test, they may start during the 1<sup>st</sup> period.

Friday Dec. 21st – **Even Class periods – 2,4,6,8.** Each class will be 2 periods long. The first period can be used to study and the second for giving the test. We will still have breaks between each period. If teachers need more time to give the test, they may start during the 1<sup>st</sup> period.

These are the **only** days the test will be given. **If you are not in attendance for the test and are not exempt, you will receive a zero.** Remember that the tests are worth 5% of your semester grade. Students will be informed of their semester grade and absences during class Wednesday. You may also use RenWeb to look at your grades and attendance by looking under the **Student Information** tab. Please remember that the first quarter and second quarter grades are averaged **together**. This grade will be the grade used to determine exemptions.

All classes will have a semester assessment (including band, P.E., and Athletics). The only exceptions to this will be study hall and encore. This grade is worth 5% of the student's overall semester grade.

Exemptions: **A - with 4 absences or less, B - with 3 absences or less**

Just a reminder--for every three tardies a student has in a class period, it will be counted as one absence.

The last day to take attendance for the first semester will be Wednesday, Dec. 19th. Thursday, Dec. 20 and Friday, Dec. 21 will not count toward the semester test exemption days.

Students with **a C or have missed more than 4 days** in an individual class will be **required** to take the semester test for that specific class.

Students who are exempt may take the test to raise their grade, but it cannot negatively affect their grade.

If a student comes to school these two days, they will be required to be in class and take the test. Parents may bring students to school for just one test and then check them back out. We do ask that parents only check students out during the passing periods or during lunch as to not disrupt those who are testing. Students are required to attend both the study period and testing period to take the test.

All students should bring a lunch from home.

3<sup>rd</sup> /4th period – 9:50 – 11:25 – Passing 11:25-11:30

Lunch – 11:30 – 12:00

5<sup>th</sup> /6th period – 12:05 - 1:40 – Passing 1:40-1:45

7<sup>th</sup> /8th period – 1:45 – 3:20
